

God is changing communities one child at a time and you are right there. **Thank you!** Here is a quote from a <u>USAID 2019</u> publication, "Many children and adolescents living in El Salvador face enormous vulnerabilities associated with high rates of crime and gang violence including poor quality education, exclusion from secondary education, early pregnancy and limited employment opportunities. School desertion rates are very high and are impacted by insecurity. Only about 50 percent of youth attend early secondary school (7th-9th grades), and only half of these go on to complete high school. There are over 300,000 youth aged 15 to 24 that neither study nor work. El Salvador has the highest homicide rate in the world for youth under the age of 19." We work together with you the local church and the community to begin to make change. Changes that have spiritual and practical goals.
